MATERIALS LIST

We recommend you use the best art materials you can afford – ASTM approved.

Cheap paints lack pigment, binder and contain lots of filler.

Good brands of Oil Paint: Art Spectrum, Winsor & Newton, Daler Rowney Georgian

Good brands of Acrylic Paint: Atelier Interactive Acrylics, Matisse or A2 Chroma (student brand)

Oil Painters or Acrylic Painters

Titanium white

Zinc or Tinting White

Lemon Yellow

** Cadmium yellow (or equivalent) [warm yellow egg-yoke colour]

Yellow ochre

Burnt sienna

Alizarin Crimson

** Cadmium Red (or equivalent) [warm red leaning towards orange type colour]

Ultramarine blue

Cobalt Blue

Prussian blue

Black

+ any other colours that you normally use

* Stretched Canvas (approx 60 x 90cm or larger)

* Flat Palette (perspex is good or disposable palette) for oil painters

* Sta-Wet Palette or flat Perspex palette or disposable meat trays (for acrylic painters)

* Rags and paper toweling.

* Odourless or Citrus Turps (oil painters)

* Painting Medium no.1 and Painting medium no.2 or Art Spectrum Wax Medium or Liquin (oil painters)

* Acrylic Mediums (Flow Medium and Retarder Medium)

* If using Interactive Brand (Slow Medium, Fast Medium Fixer, Unlocking Medium, Clear Medium).

* Selection of brushes - taklon and bristle – mostly flats (square shaped)

* 2 glass bottles with lids (for oil painters)

* water container (medium to large – old yoghurt containers are good) for acrylic painters

* note book and pen
